## JOINT RESOLUTION

Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the United States to prohibit the President from making recess appointments.

1       *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*  
2       *of the United States of America in Congress assembled*  
3       *(two-thirds of each House concurring therein), That the fol-*  
4       *lowing article is proposed as an amendment to the Con-*  
5       *stitution of the United States, which shall be valid to all*  
6       *intents and purposes as part of the Constitution when*  
7       *ratified by the legislatures of three-fourths of the several*

1 States within seven years after the date of its submission  
2 for ratification:

3 “ARTICLE—

4 “The President shall not have the power to fill up  
5 any vacancy during the recess of the Senate.”.
